



**! CATCH THIS SIGHT and SITE WHILE YOU CAN !**

**Question:** What's this old broken "viewing" box covering, but not for much longer? We hope to begin new installation work on September 10, 2018, or soon thereafter. We'll reveal final work informally this fall; formally for the 2019 Bicentennial.

**Answer:** Your Huntsville-Madison County **Historical Society** has been working to research, repair, and reveal hand-made bricks that were laid in the mid-1800's. They're practically invisible and mossy, below street level at 205 Eastside Square--in front of the old Law Library.

We're partnering with **The Historic Huntsville Foundation**, for key financial support and administrative guidance.

Other supporters include UAH's public history program, HSV's General Services department, archeologist at Redstone Arsenal, civil war round table, and local citizens, artists and photographers. Their donations are mainly "in-kind," so we'll need more funding.

**Here's what some new signage will say:**

"In the mid-1800's, masons sculpted local clay into these bricks and created this sidewalk. What once served as a humble walkway for farmers, merchants, and pedestrians now links you to Huntsville's past and to all those who trod where you are currently standing."

**Putting a "buck-in-the-brick" will help us finish the work.**

The project is costing nearly \$5,000—and some of this already is covered by our partners. Your **tax-deductible contribution** (we're a 501c3 non-profit organization) can go toward lighting the interior and developing new educational materials.
