► Eligibility

The following students are eligible for the John Rison Jones Award for Southern History:

- Students of a college history program (undergraduate & graduate)
- High school-aged students, with an enthusiasm for history (homeschooled, public or private schools)
- The school must be in Madison County

► Paper Requirements – Student Checklist

Please check the criteria you have met:

- Content focused on Southern history, with an emphasis on local impact; including but not limited to (**check the content that most closely describes your paper**):
 - City/town/county history
 - Biographic information of citizens
 - Institutional/organizational/ business history
 - Contextual interpretation
 - Narrative storytelling (should still be historically accurate and include citations for information provided in the narrative. Indicate in cover page that the submission is in narrative storytelling format.)
 - Transcripts of oral histories
 - Book reviews of scholarly work
- Page count
 - Minimum 5 pages for high school-aged students
 - Minimum 10 pages for college students
- Include appropriate citations (Chicago or MLA)
 - Footnotes or endnotes accepted, in addition to Citations. (Footnotes and endnotes are encouraged, but are not required)
 - Citations pages and endnotes are not included in total page count.
- Format
 - Include a COMPLETED SUBMISSION FORM
 - Pages should be double-spaced and have 1” margins
 - 12-point font, either Times New Roman or Calibri
 - Submit as a Word Document or PDF
 - Images are encouraged, though not required
- Papers may be:
 - from a previous school assignment
 - a brand new work product
